We have recently had a change of management with a renewed focus on the needs of the community.

- 1. **Medical 911 calls**: we are intent on filling the medical care gap between when the 911 call is made until when an ambulance arrives.
- 2. <u>Medical Equipment</u>: arming all of our members with an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) and other upgraded items to help with treatment. AEDs when coupled with CPR can make a lifesaving difference. Outfitting our backpacks for hard-to-reach medical emergencies.
- 3. <u>Emergency medical classes</u>: we offer life saving CPR/AED and Stop the Bleed classes to the public.
- 4. **Station Renovation**: our station is on the older side and requires renovation. The money we receive from the ESD (Emergency Services District) can only cover so much. We are currently putting in hours of labor to provide a much needed uplift to our building. We want every member of the SJCFRs and our community to take satisfaction in our station and utilize it as a hub for hosting educational classes and events.
- 5. <u>Community Events</u>: our volunteers support various local events such as Shattered Lives, Church Revival, Career Day, and classroom instruction.
- 6. **Financial Transparency**: we believe in openness with the public regarding our financials since we rely mainly on the public for funding through taxes (ESD, donations, fundraisers, and grants.
